OECC opens a half day preschool program this Fall. The half day preschool will serve children ages three to kindergarten, and will run from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. or 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., five days a week, year round.

The expanded preschool option has been added in response to community needs. With the help of OberlinKids, we are working together with other high quality preschools in Oberlin, to eliminate early learning gaps. We believe that all children should have access to at least one year of high quality early learning.

Along with our current programming, the part day program will also be offered on a sliding fee scale. We will continue to offer scholarships and accept ODJFS child care subsidies for the program as well.
